  - j. Photographs
  - k. Outlet Covers/Switch Plates
  - I. Remove Wall hangings (May be left in room)
  - m. Plastic Blinds
  - n. Fire Extinguishers
  - o. Plastic Exit Signs
  - p. Smoke Detectors
  - q. Plastic Air Conditioning Faceplates
  - r. Lipstick
  - s. Batteries
  - t. Pressurized Cans (Hairspray, etc.)

- III. Areas That may Need To Be Addressed:
  - a. Ensure Facility Is Clean
  - b. Printers/Computers/TVs and Monitors
  - c. Secure Loose Wallpaper
  - d. Unplug Refrigerator
  - e. Wax Seal
  - f. Sprinkler heads Set to 185 degrees F. (Disable)
  - g. Have water faucets on slightly
  - h. Separate objects and Clothing Items in each Room
  - i. Laminated Furniture
  - j. Move Furniture Away From Walls
  - k. Treat Adjacent Rooms
  - I. Life Safety Systems-wiring behind the walls
